Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-three.

AN ACT

To provide for the Appointment and Removal of Members of the Board of Prison Commissioners, the Warden and Other Officers of the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The governor is hereby given full
2 authority to remove, for cause stated, after due
3 hearing, any member of the board of prison com-
4 missioners. The board of prison commissioners
5 are hereby given full power to appoint, and for
6 cause stated, after due hearing, to remove, the
7 warden of the state prison at Boston.

1 SECT. 2. The warden of the state prison at
2 Boston shall, subject to the provisions of chapter
3 three hundred and twenty of the acts of the year
4 eighteen hundred and eighty-four, and the rules
5 of the civil service commissioners thereunder,
6 have authority to appoint and remove all the
7 officers of said prison, except the chaplain and
8 physician and surgeon.

1 SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts incon-
2 sistent herewith are hereby repealed.
