

present political year, for the purposes and under the provisions and limitations mentioned in chapter twenty-two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, which shall be allowed and paid.

Bounty loan sinking fund. 1863, 91, § 5.

To the bounty loan sinking fund, established under chapter ninety-one of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-three, to be invested in accordance with the provisions of section five of said chapter, the sum of twenty thousand dollars.

Museum of comparative zoölogy. Williams college.

To the museum of comparative zoölogy, and to the president and trustees of Williams college, each twenty-five thousand dollars, payable in accordance with the provisions of chapter sixty-four of the resolves of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.

Harbor commissioners. 1866, 149.

For compensation and expenses of the harbor commissioners, a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars, payable upon vouchers properly approved and filed with the auditor for his certificate.

Flats in Boston harbor.

In the act relating to certain works on the Commonwealth flats in Boston harbor, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars, for the compensation and expenses of the engineer therein provided for.

Commissioners on river fisheries.

Of the appropriation made in chapter three hundred and thirty-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, for expenses of the commissioners on river fisheries, there is hereby re-appropriated a sum not exceeding eight hundred sixteen dollars and fifty-two cents; and of the appropriation made in chapter three hundred and forty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, for expenses of said commissioners, there is hereby re-appropriated a sum not exceeding three thousand two hundred dollars and twenty-one cents.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 37. AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TRUSTEES OF MOUNT HOLYOKE FEMALE SEMINARY TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE.

Be it enacted, &c, as follows:

\$400,000 additional real and personal estate.

SECTION 1. The trustees of the Mount Holyoke Female Seminary are hereby authorized to hold real and personal estate to the amount of four hundred thousand dollars, in addition to the amount which they are now authorized to hold, to be devoted exclusively to the purposes of education.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
