

SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:— Applicants for registration shall also comply with the provisions of chapter ninety D.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on September the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-two. *Approved September 9, 1971.*

**Chap. 755. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN COUNTY EMPLOYEES.**

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide without delay additional compensation for certain officers and employees of certain counties, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Paragraph (1) of section 51B of chapter 35 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the salary schedule, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 858 of the acts of 1969, and inserting in place thereof the following schedule:—

SECTION 2. The salary of each officer and employee in the service of the various counties, except Suffolk, and paid from the treasury thereof, other than an officer or employee with a salary fixed by statute, but including official stenographers whose salaries are fixed under the provisions of chapter six hundred and fifty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six, or an employee whose salary is increased by section one of this act, shall be increased over the rate paid December the thirty-first, nineteen hundred and seventy by an amount equal to six per cent thereof.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of January the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

*(This Bill, returned by the governor, to the House of Representatives, the branch in which it originated, with his objections thereto, was passed by the House of Representatives, September 13, 1971, and, in concurrence, by the Senate, September 13, 1971, the objections of the governor notwithstanding, in the manner prescribed by the constitution; and thereby has "the force of a law".)*

**Chap. 756.** AN ACT EXTENDING BENEFITS UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

*Whereas,* The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish for weeks beginning on or after September the nineteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, a program further extending benefits under the employment security law, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 30A of chapter 151A of the General Laws, inserted by section 1 of chapter 866 of the acts of 1970, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: —

If the Federal-State Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 1970 is amended so as to authorize the commonwealth to pay benefits for a period of extended duration beyond that currently provided by this section, the amended provisions of such federal law shall become a part of this section to the extent necessary to authorize the payment of benefits for such extended duration.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 151A is hereby further amended by inserting after section 30A the following section: —

*Section 30B.* (a) An individual who, with respect to his applicable benefit year, has exhausted all the extended benefits to which he is entitled under the provisions of section thirty A shall, except as otherwise provided in this section, be eligible for additional benefits under the same terms and conditions as provided in section thirty A.

(b) The weekly benefit amount shall be the amount as was determined under subsection (4) of section thirty A.

(c) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, the total amount of additional benefits payable to an eligible individual with respect to his applicable benefit year shall be the total amount of extended benefits which were payable to him.
