AN ACT ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT OF NOTIFICATION OF POLICE FOR INTENT TO SELL DRUGS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding after
3 section 32J the following new section: —

4 Section 32L. Any administrator in charge of a secondary
5 school, including but not limited to faculty, who fails to report
6 to the local police a student's possession of narcotics with intent
7 to sell on school grounds shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and
8 punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars.
