### AN ACT RELATIVE TO SEASONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 453 of the acts of 1970, is hereby further  
3 amended by inserting, after the sixth paragraph the following  
4 paragraph:—

5 The local licensing authorities of a city or town which grants  
6 seasonal licenses under section twelve, may upon application of  
7 such license, extend the effective period of said license to December  
8 the thirty-first of each year. Notice of granting of such an extension  
9 shall be forwarded forthwith to the commission.
