AN ACT AUTHORIZING FREE ACCESS TO TELECOMMUNICATION FACILITIES  
ON MOUNT GREYLOCK FOR STATE AGENCIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding contrary provisions of any general or special  
2 law, access to the telecommunications facilities located on land  
3 owned by the commonwealth at Mount Greylock in the county  
4 of Berkshire shall be provided without charge to the general court  
5 and officers of state agencies.
