**AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN PREMISES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 16C of chapter 138 of the General Laws as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 586 of the acts of 1971 is hereby  
3 amended by adding the following new paragraph: —

4 This section shall not apply to licensed premises if the said  
5 premises and the church or school are both located in a  
6 business or industrial zone as defined in the zoning ordinance  
7 of by-laws of a city or town.

AN ACT TO REORGANIZE THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA GOVERNMENT

As it appears in the District of Columbia Code, the Commission on the Administration of the Government of the District of Columbia

- 1 Section 102 of Chapter 118 of the District Code is amended to read as follows:
- 2 "The Commission on the Administration of the Government of the District of Columbia shall be composed of the following members:
- 3 (a) The Mayor of the District of Columbia.
- 4 (b) The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of the District of Columbia.
- 5 (c) The Chairman of the Board of Directors of the District of Columbia.
- 6 (d) The Chairman of the Board of Directors of the District of Columbia.
