AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS AND ASSISTANT REGISTERS OF DEEDS FOR THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 33 of chapter 36 of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out
3 the paragraph added by section 2 of chapter 664 of
4 the acts of 1948 and inserting in place thereof the
5 following:—

6 The salary of the register of deeds for the county of
7 Suffolk shall be the same as the salary of the clerk
8 of the superior court for civil and criminal business
9 for the county of Suffolk; the salary of the first as-
10 sistant register of deeds for said county shall be
11 seventy-five per cent of the salary of said register;
12 and the salaries of all other assistant registers of deeds
13 for said county shall be sixty-five per cent of the
14 salary of said register.
