## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Nine.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DRUG FREE HOUSING, SKATING RINK AND SWIMMING POOL ZONES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 32J of chapter 94C of the General Laws,  
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 inserting, in line 5, after the word "session" the following  
4 words:— in or within one thousand feet of real property com-  
5 prising a public swimming pool or public or private skating rink,  
6 or public or subsidized housing development, project or unit.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 32J of said chapter 94C, as so  
2 inserted, is hereby further amended by inserting, in line 19, after  
3 the word "school" the following words:— or public swimming  
4 pools or public or private skating rink, or public or subsidized  
5 housing development, project or unit.
