RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF WILLIAM B. ROGERS.

1 *Resolved*, That, after an appropriation therefor has
2 been made from the Highway Fund, the department
3 of public works may pay to William B. Rogers the
4 sum of sixteen hundred and seventy-five dollars in full
5 compensation for certain parcels of land owned by
6 said William B. Rogers which were taken by eminent
7 domain under chapter seventy-nine of the General
8 Laws by said department, in connection with the
9 construction by the Commonwealth of the Boston
10 Worcester Turnpike, so-called, and for any and all
11 damages to other land of William B. Rogers arising
12 out of said taking.
