AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS TO NURSING AND CONVALESCENT HOMES IN ADDITION TO THE RATE ESTABLISHED THEREON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30L of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 809 of the acts of
3 1963, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof
4 the following paragraph:—

5 Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the
6 authority of such departments, boards, commissions or subdi-
7 visions to pay such nursing or convalescent homes a higher
8 rate than the minimum per diem rate or rates established
9 hereunder; provided, however, that where rates so paid are
10 subject to regulation by the department of public welfare, no
11 city or town shall be entitled to reimbursement from the
12 commonwealth with respect to the amount by which such
13 rates exceed rates approved by such department.
