AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Whitman to take by Purchase a Certain Lot of Land Adjoining its Public Park for the Purpose of Enlarging Said Park.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Whitman may, at any
2 time within one year from the passage of this act,
3 take by purchase for the purpose of enlarging its
4 public park, known as Whitman Park, all or any
5 part of the land in said town adjoining said park
6 and bounded as follows: Beginning at the south-
7 east corner of the premises on Whitman Avenue
8 and at the southwest corner of land of Edward
9 Y. Perry; thence north seven degrees east about
10 two hundred and one-half ($200\frac{1}{2}$) feet by said
11 land of said Perry to said Whitman Park; thence

12 by said park south eighty-four degrees forty min-
13 utes west five hundred and fifty-three (553) feet
14 to said park; thence by said park south forty
15 degrees thirty minutes east one hundred (100)
16 feet to said Whitman Avenue; thence by said
17 Whitman Avenue north eighty-four degrees forty-
18 five minutes east one hundred and fifty (150)
19 feet; thence by said avenue south eighty-seven
20 degrees fifteen minutes east three hundred and
21 seventy-six (376) feet to the first-named bound.

1 SECT. 2. Said town may raise and expend
2 such a sum of money as may be necessary for the
3 purchase of said addition to said park, subject to
4 the law limiting municipal indebtedness.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
