### DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether Dudley Chateau of Cochituate, Inc. (licensee) was in violation of Ch. 138, §23- Sale of alcoholic beverages other than those purchased under §18 or §19 or from a holder of a special permit under §22A (7 counts).

The licensee stipulated to the Investigator's report. Investigator Brad Doyle testified that on January 22, 2009 he and Investigator Hooton entered the licensed premises of the Dudley Chateau in order to determine its manner of business. Upon inspecting the bar area, they observed seven bottles with what appeared to them, as being glue residue in the size and shape of a retail price sticker, affixed on them. They took inventory and recorded the seven bottles of alcoholic beverages. They then spoke to the manager on duty who admitted to occasionally purchasing alcohol from a local package store.

The Commission finds the licensee in violation of Ch. 138, §23- Sale of alcoholic beverages other than those purchased under §18 or §19 or from a holder of a special permit under §22A (7 counts) and, therefore, **suspends the license for 7 days of which 3 days will be held in abeyance for a period of two years provided no further violations of Ch. 138 or Commission regulations occur.**
