**AN ACT PROVIDING THAT AN APPEAL FROM CERTAIN CONVICTIONS SHALL STAY THE RIGHT OF THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO SUSPEND THE RIGHT OF SUCH APPELLANT TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subdivision (1) of section 24 of chapter 90 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (b), as most  
3 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 200 of the acts of  
4 1964, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —  
5 (b) A conviction of a violation of the preceding paragraph  
6 of this section shall be reported forthwith by the court or  
7 magistrate to the registrar, who shall revoke immediately the  
8 license or the right to operate of the person so convicted;  
9 provided, however, that an appeal, motion for new trial or  
10 exceptions shall operate to stay the revocation of the license or  
11 right to operate.
