AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE FILING OF EXECUTIVE REGULATIONS WITH THE LEGISLATURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 30A of the general laws as
2 most recently amended by section 4 of chapter 712 of the acts of
3 1970 is hereby amended by striking out in the second sentence
4 of the third paragraph the words: – upon request.

1 SECTION 2. Said section is further amended by adding in the
2 second sentence of the third paragraph after the words “respec-
3 tively, and” the following words: – upon request.

1 SECTION 3. Said section is further amended by adding in the
2 first sentence of the fourth paragraph after the word “three” the
3 words: – and transmit a free copy of the same to the clerk of the
4 house of representatives and of the senate and to the counsel
5 thereof, respectively,.

1 SECTION 4. Section 37 of chapter 30 of the General Laws
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 712 of the acts
3 of 1970 is hereby amended by adding in the first sentence after
4 the word “secretary” the words: – and with the clerk of the
5 house of representatives and of the senate and with the counsel
6 thereof, respectively.
