**AN ACT RELATIVE TO QUALIFYING WAGES FOR UNEMPLOYMENT
COMPENSATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out subsection (a) of section twenty-four and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following subsection (a): —
- 4 (a) have been paid wages in the base period amounting to at
- 5 least thirty times the weekly benefit rate, but not less than twenty-
- 6 four hundred dollars.
