AN ACT TO REPEAL THE "FAIR TRADE LAW".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Sections fourteen A, fourteen B, fourteen C and fourteen D
2 of chapter ninety-three of the general laws are hereby repealed.

The Constitution of Pennsylvania

As amended by the Convention of 1872

As amended by the "Act of 1890"

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened that the University of Pennsylvania be defined as follows:

1. That the University of Pennsylvania be defined as follows: The University of Pennsylvania shall be a body corporate and shall have the right to acquire, hold, and dispose of real and personal property, to sue and be sued, to contract, and to do all such things as may be necessary or proper to carry out its purposes.
