## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING SCHOOL COMMITTEES TO CONTRACT FOR THE HIRE OF ATHLETIC COACHES FOR PERIODS NOT EXCEEDING THREE YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 47, as most recently amended  
3 by section 1 of chapter 316 of the acts of 1952, the  
4 following section:—

5 *Section 47A.* The committee may contract to em-  
6 ploy athletic coaches for periods not in excess of three  
7 years. The provisions of section forty-one relative to  
8 tenure shall not apply to such athletic coaches, unless  
9 they are otherwise entitled to tenure.
