

SENATE No. 206

To accompany the petition of Mason Garfield for the appointment of a special commission to investigate the sale of raw milk. Agriculture and Public Health, sitting jointly.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Nine.

Resolve creating a Special Unpaid Commission to investigate the Sale of Raw Milk.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid commission consisting
2 of five citizens of the commonwealth to be ap-
3 pointed by the governor, with the advice and
4 consent of the council, to inquire into the sale of
5 raw milk in the commonwealth, and, for the pur-
6 pose of safeguarding the public health, to propose
7 adequate legislation for the efficient and effective
8 control of the sale of raw milk and cream. The
9 commission shall report to the general court the
10 result of its investigation, together with its recom-
11 mendations and drafts of legislation embodying
12 the same, by filing the same with the clerk of the
13 senate not later than the second Thursday in
14 January, nineteen hundred and thirty.

15 The commission may incur such reasonable
16 expenses, including such sums for traveling,
17 clerical and other assistance, and expenses actually
18 incurred by the commissioners in the discharge of
19 their duties, as may be approved by the governor
20 and council, but not exceeding such sum as the
21 general court may appropriate.
