AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE JUSTICE TO ENTER INTO A LEASE EXCEEDING FIVE YEARS IN DURATION FOR A NEW DISTRICT COURT FACILITY IN BROCKTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 29A of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 579 of the acts of 1980 is further amended
3 by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph: —

4 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, or of any other
5 provision of law, the chief administrative justice shall have the
6 authority to enter into a lease exceeding five years in duration and
7 upon such terms and conditions as he deems appropriate for a
8 new District Court facility for the Brockton Division, District
9 Court Department.
