An Act to increase the Capital Stock of the Prescott Bank of Lowell. *Chap. 225*

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECT. 1. The president, directors, and company, of the Prescott Bank, of Lowell, are hereby authorized to increase their present capital stock by an addition thereto of fifty thousand dollars, in shares of one hundred dollars each, which shall be paid in such instalments as the president and directors may determine: *provided*, that the whole amount shall be paid in before the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four. Additional capital \$50,000.
Proviso.

SECT. 2. If any of the stockholders of said bank remonstrate against the acceptance of the additional capital herein provided, the said remonstrance shall be made in writing to the cashier of the bank on or before the first day of July next, and if the persons so objecting, legally represent one-fourth part of the present capital stock of said corporation, it shall not be entitled to the benefit of this act. Chap. 226 An Act to increase the Capital Stock of the Lynn Mechanics Bank

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

* Additional capital \$50,000.

SECT. 1. The president, directors, and company, of the Lynn Mechanics Bank, in Lynn, are hereby authorized to increase their present capital stock by an addition thereto of fifty thousand dollars, in shares of one hundred dollars each, which shall be paid in such instalments as the president and directors may determine: *provided*, that the whole amount shall be paid in before the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four.

Proviso.

Remonstrance to be in writing.

SECT. 2. If any of the stockholders of said bank remonstrate against the acceptance of the additional capital herein provided, the said remonstrance shall be made in writing to the cashier of the bank on or before the first day of July next, and if the persons so objecting, legally represent one-fourth part of the capital stock of said corporation, it shall not be entitled to the benefit of this act.
