In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act to validate Certain Elections of the Town of
Halifax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The votes of the town of Halifax at its annual
2 meetings held in nineteen hundred and thirty-four
3 and nineteen hundred and thirty-five for the election
4 of town officers, so far as such votes were invalid by
5 reason of its failure to comply with the provisions of
6 general laws in effect on that date and with the pro-
7 visions of the by-laws of said town, are hereby made
8 valid and the official acts of all town officers declared
9 to be elected at said meetings or either of them
10 between said date and the passage of this act are
11 hereby ratified and confirmed to the same extent as
12 if said town had complied with the provisions of gen-
13 eral laws and the by-laws.
