## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act establishing the Salary of the Police Commissioner for the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter two hundred  
2 and ninety-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
3 six, as amended by chapter three hundred and seven  
4 of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred and seven-  
5 teen and by chapter eight of the acts of nineteen  
6 hundred and twenty, is hereby further amended by  
7 striking out, in the second line, the word "eight"  
8 and inserting in place thereof the word: — twelve, —  
9 so that the *first paragraph* of said section will read  
10 as follows: —

11 *Section 8.* The annual salary of the police com-  
12 missioner shall be twelve thousand dollars, and of  
13 the secretary an amount which shall be fixed by  
14 the police commissioner with the approval of the  
15 governor and council, which shall be paid in monthly  
16 instalments by the city of Boston. Subject to the

17 approval of the governor and council, the police  
18 commissioner shall be provided with such rooms,  
19 which shall be suitably furnished, as shall be con-  
20 venient and suitable for the performance of his  
21 duties, the expense of which shall be paid by the  
22 city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
