AN ACT CLARIFYING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW RELATIVE TO ROSTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 31 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the definition of the word
3 "Roster" and inserting in place thereof the following defini-
4 tion:—

5 "Roster", a list of permanent civil service employees in a
6 department, arranged according to seniority, and supple-
7 mented by a list of employees appointed on a temporary or
8 provisional basis.

1 SECTION 2. Section 31B of said chapter 31 is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end of the first sentence the
3 following words:—, and each appointing authority shall be
4 given a copy of the roster for his department;—and by
5 striking out of the second sentence the first word, "He", and
6 inserting in place thereof the following words:—The director.
