AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF PROSPECTIVE JURORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 234 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after the second sentence the following sentence: — In
- 3 no case shall the board disqualify a person from appearing on said
- 4 list solely because that person is blind.
