AN ACT AUTHORIZING A DEDUCTION FOR PAYMENT OF PREMIUMS FOR HOSPITALIZATION, MEDICAL AND SURGICAL INSURANCE FROM PENSIONS OF RETIRED SCHOOL TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 19 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 691 of the acts of 1956, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the last two sentences and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— In the
5 case of a retired teacher who is receiving his retirement allow-
6 ance from the teachers' retirement system, any assignment for
7 the payment of monthly premiums, for coverage under group
8 policies issued under chapter thirty-two B, shall be permitted
9 only in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed by
10 the teachers' retirement board, and such rules and regulations
11 governing such assignments shall not be subject to the provi-
12 sions of chapter thirty A.
