The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act providing for the Taxation of Sales of Motor Vehicle Fuel used in Diesel and Other Engines of Different Type from the Gasoline Engine in Common Use.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter sixty-four A of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out paragraph
3 (d) and inserting in place thereof the following:—
4 (d) "Fuel" shall include gasoline, benzol, fuel oil
5 and any other products used in propelling motor
6 vehicles on the public ways of the commonwealth.
