## RESOLUTIONS IN MEMORY OF CAPTAIN TIMOTHY DEASY.

1     *Whereas*, Captain Timothy Deasy, born in Clonakilty, County  
2 Cork, Ireland in 1841, emigrated to Lawrence, Massachusetts in  
3 1847 with his family and enlisted in Company I, Ninth  
4 Massachusetts Vol. Infantry in 1861 and was promoted from the  
5 ranks for conspicuous gallantry and bravery to the rank of First  
6 Lieutenant and he fought through 32 engagements during the  
7 Civil War; and

8     *Whereas*, In 1864, he left the United States for Ireland where  
9 he became a Captain in the Irish Republican Brotherhood and in  
10 1866 led a 200 man cavalry detachment in the Fenian Invasion  
11 of Canada by Irish troops, and he played a prominent role in  
12 many of the most dramatic and historic episodes during the Irish  
13 Revolution between 1864 and 1871, being eventually promoted  
14 to Second-in-Command of the entire Fenian Movement, under  
15 Colonel Thomas Kelly; and

16     *Whereas*, In 1872 he was elected to the Lawrence City Council  
17 and in 1877 was elected from Lawrence to serve in the  
18 Massachusetts House of Representatives, and his remarkable  
19 career came to an untimely end when he died in Lawrence at the  
20 age of 39; and

21     *Whereas*, The people of Ireland will honor him this September  
22 by dedicating space in the Cork City Museum in his memory for  
23 his service to his native homeland; and

24     *Whereas*, Captain Deasy served his homeland, Ireland, his  
25 country, the United States, his city, Lawrence and his Common-  
26 wealth with distinction; therefore be it

27     *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives  
28 take this opportunity to honor the memory of one of its former  
29 members, Captain Timothy Deasy; and be it further

30     *Resolved*, That an engrossed copy of these resolutions be

31 forwarded by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the  
32 President, Division 8, Ancient Order of Hibernians, Lawrence.
