Bill accompanying the petition of Samuel L. Blumenthal and others for legislation to prohibit the throwing or depositing of partially used cigars or cigarettes in or near any public place. Public Health. January 13.

AN ACT

To prohibit the Placing or Depositing of partially used
Cigars or Cigarettes in Public Places.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Whoever places, throws or deposits a partially used
2 cigar or cigarette, without completely destroying the
3 shape or form thereof, on any public street or in any
4 public place, or so near to a public street or public place
5 as to be of easy access, shall be punished by a fine not
6 exceeding ten dollars.
