## AN ACT TO PROVIDE AFFORDABLE HEALTH INSURANCE THROUGH THE GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Section 8 of  
2 chapter 32A of the General Laws is amended by striking the words "seventy-five percent" in  
3 lineS 5, 8, 32, and 38 and inserting the words "fifteen percent."
