AN ACT REDUCING THE AGE AT WHICH PERSONS SHALL  
BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE OLD AGE ASSISTANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section one of chapter one hundred and eighteen A  
2 of the General Laws, as amended, is hereby further  
3 amended by striking out, in the third and thirteenth  
4 lines, as appearing in chapter four hundred and forty  
5 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, the  
6 word "sixty-five" and inserting in place thereof in  
7 each instance the word: — sixty.
