To accompany the petition of Andrew P. Quigley that provision be made for the improvement and beautification of Revere Beach by the Metropolitan District Commission. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND BEAUTIFICATION OF REVERE BEACH BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to improve, beautify and
3 develop Revere beach, to grade and sand said beach, to
4 install recreational facilities and shelter thereat, to
5 install receptacles for litter, to renovate the bathhouse,
6 and to increase and improve the facilities thereof.
7 For the purpose of this act the said commission may
8 expend such sum, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one
9 million dollars, as may be hereafter appropriated.
