RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF RAYMOND V. PALMEGIANO OF THE CITY KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF METHUEN AND FRANCIS X. HARRISON OF THE TOWN OF CHELMSFORD.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral  
2 obligation of the Commonwealth, there shall be allowed and  
3 paidout of the state treasury, subject to appropriation, to  
4 Raymond V. Palmegiano, of the city known as the town of  
5 Methuen, the sum of forty-one thousand six hundred seventy  
6 dollars and to Francis X. Harrison, of the town of Chelmsford  
7 the sum of fifty-four thousand three hundred forty-one dollars and  
8 thirty-nine cents as reimbursement for legal expenses incurred by  
9 them between December nineteen hundred and eighty-two and  
10 November nineteen hundred and eighty-three, in defending a  
11 criminal prosecution brought against them by the Common-  
12 wealth.
