AN ACT EQUALIZING PENSIONS PAYABLE UNDER THE PERMANENT SCHOOL PENSION FUND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The pension payable to any person en-
2 titled to pension under the provisions of chapter four
3 hundred sixty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred fifty-
4 one, as from time to time amended, shall in every case
5 be equal to the maximum pension which would have
6 been payable to any person retiring at any earlier date
7 under the provisions of said law who at the time of re-
8 tirement was of the same age and had the same period
9 of service.

1 SECTION 2. The amount of the pension of any person
2 retired before the effective date of this act under chapter
3 four hundred sixty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred
4 fifty-one, as from time to time amended, whose pension
5 is increased by this act, shall be re-established in accord-
6 ance with the provisions of this act to date from the
7 first day of the calendar month next following the pas-
8 sage of this act. Nothing in this act shall be construed
9 to decrease the amount of any pension now being paid
10 to any person.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the city
3 council of the city of Boston, subject to the provisions of
4 its charter, but not otherwise.
