

# SENATE . . . . No. 190.

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[Mr. BARKER moves that the Senate Report of the committee on Agriculture, reference to the next General Court, in accordance with the requirements of Joint Rule No. 10, on the fourth report of the State Board of Agriculture on the work of extermination of the gypsy moth (Senate, No. 6), be amended by the substitution of this resolve.]

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## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-six.

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### RESOLVE

Providing against Depredations by the Insect known as the  
Ocneria Dispar or Gypsy Moth.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding fifty  
3 thousand dollars, to be expended under the direction of  
4 the state board of agriculture for continuing the work of  
5 suppressing and preventing the spread of the gypsy moth  
6 as provided in chapter two hundred and ten of the acts  
7 of eighteen hundred and ninety-one: *provided*, that not  
8 exceeding five thousand dollars of the above named sum  
9 may be expended for the introduction of foreign parasites  
10 under the direction of the entomologist for the committee  
11 on the gypsy moth. The above sum shall be in addition  
12 to any balance remaining unexpended of the appropria-  
13 tion of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five.
