RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH RELATIVE TO THE USE OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY RESERVOIRS FOR FISHING AND RELATED ACTIVITIES.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the use of any or all public water supply reservoirs
4 in the commonwealth for fishing and related activities. Said
5 department shall report to the general court the results of its
6 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
9 of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednes-
10 day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.
