AN ACT REQUIRING THAT TWO HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS OF THE AUTHORIZATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NOTES AND BONDS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY BE USED FOR ELDERLY HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of section 8 of chapter 708 of the
2 acts of 1966, as amended by chapter 971 of the acts of 1971,
3 is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the last
4 sentence the following — And not less than two hundred
5 million dollars shall be used in connection with the construc-
6 tion, reconstruction, renovation and repair of housing for the
7 elderly.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
