

HOUSE No. 2509

By Mr. Lawton of Brockton, petition of Mark E. Lawton relative to excluding certain public employees from the provisions of law relative to unused sick leave and early retirement incentives. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE AMENDMENT TO THE DEFINITION OF "REGULAR COMPENSATION" UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES SHALL NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 681 of the acts of 1979 is hereby amended by adding the
2 following paragraph:—

3 The provisions of this act excluding severance pay for unused
4 sick leave and early retirement incentives from the calculation of
5 the salary, wages or other compensation of an employee for pur-
6 poses of the definition of "regular compensation" during any peri-
7 od subsequent to December 31, 1945 shall not apply to those
8 employees who had entered into written contracts of employment
9 with any city or town prior to July 1, 1979.
