[Bill accompanying the petition of the Trustees of Wesleyan Academy for an amendment of its charter.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-three.

AN ACT

To amend an Act to incorporate an Academy in the Town of Wilbraham, by the Name of the Wesleyan Academy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter eighty of the acts
2 of the year eighteen hundred and twenty-three is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 *Section 4.* The trustees of said academy may have a
5 common seal which they may change at pleasure, and all
6 deeds and other conveyances of real estate made after
7 the acceptance of this act as hereinafter provided shall,
8 when authorized by said trustees, be sealed with said
9 seal and be signed with the corporate name of said trus-

10 tees by the president and treasurer and acknowledged
11 by one of them. Said trustees may sue and be sued in
12 all actions, and prosecute and defend the same to final
13 judgment and execution by the name of the trustees of
14 the Wesleyan Academy.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall not take effect unless accepted
2 by the said trustees at their next annual meeting held after
3 the passage hereof.
