AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SERVICE OF PROCESS UNDER THE UNIFORM RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF SUPPORT ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 273A of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 42 of the acts of 1960, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence:— All processes under
5 this chapter may be made by any officer authorized under the
6 laws of the commonwealth to serve criminal process.
