### AN ACT RELATIVE TO EDUCATIONAL USES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The second paragraph of section 3 of Chapter 40A of the  
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 860 of the  
3 acts of 1977, is hereby further amended by adding after the first  
4 sentence the following sentence: — For the purposes of this  
5 chapter, the use of land and structures as a residential rehabilita-  
6 tion facility shall not be considered an educational use, nor shall  
7 the facility be considered an educational facility.
