AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR A FALSE ALARM IN A MEDICAL EMERGENCY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 13 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after Section 13A, a new Section 13B as
- 3 follows: —
- 4 Section 13B. False reports of medical emergency
- 5 Whoever intentionally and knowingly makes or causes to be
- 6 made a false report of medical emergency or circumstance of any
- 7 individual in need of medical aid shall be punished by a fine of
- 8 not less than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars or
- 9 by imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more than
- 10 one year or both.
