1     *Ordered*, That the committee on Public Service be authorized  
2 to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of  
3 making an investigation and study of public employee personnel  
4 administration in the Commonwealth. In the course of its  
5 investigation and study, the committee shall consider the subject-  
6 matter of current House document numbered 5694.

7     Said committee shall report to the General Court the results  
8 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
9 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
10 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of  
11 the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday  
12 in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.
