AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS CIVIL DEFENSE AGENCY AND
OFFICE OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 48 of Chapter 31 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 767 of the acts of 1981, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out in the first paragraph the words
4 "civil defense agency" and inserting in place thereof the fol-
5 lowing: — "Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency"

1 SECTION 2. Section 5 of Chapter 40 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by Chapter 351 of the acts of 1981, is
3 hereby further amended by striking the words "civil defense
4 agency" in clause (62) and inserting in place thereof the fol-
5 lowing: — "Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency"

1 SECTION 3. The fortieth clause of Section 5 of Chapter 59 of
2 the General Laws, as added by chapter 345 of the acts of 1963, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the words "civil defense agency"
4 and inserting in place thereof the following: — "Massachusetts
5 Emergency Management Agency"

1 SECTION 4. Section 10-H of Chapter 147 of the General
2 Laws, as added by chapter 176 of the acts of 1968, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the words "civil defense agency" wherever
4 they appear and inserting in place thereof the following: —
5 "Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency"

1 SECTION 5. Chapter 639 of the Acts of 1950, as amended, is
2 hereby further amended by striking out the words “civil defense
3 agency and office of emergency preparedness’ wherever they
4 appear and inserting in place thereof the following: — “Massa-
5 chusetts Emergency Management Agency”
