### AN ACT TO DEFINE INSURANCE IN FORCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section one of chapter one hundred and seventy-  
2 five of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding  
3 after the definition of "Insurance Company" the  
4 following sentence:—

5 "Insurance in force" shall mean the aggregate  
6 amount of a company's maximum liabilities numeri-  
7 cally specified in all its outstanding policies.
