AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE TRANSFER OF TITLE OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHOUT PROBATE UPON DEATH OF THE OWNER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 195 section 16 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 405 of the Acts of 1972 is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the words "two thousand dollars" the
4 following: — "excluding any motor vehicle used exclusively for
5 personal, non-business purposes of which the decedent is the
6 owner".
