

By Mr. Crowley of Somerville, petition of Robert J. Muldoon that certain certificates accompany applications for the registration of motor vehicles of corporations under the supervision of the Department of Public Utilities. Insurance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act amending the Compulsory Motor Vehicle Insurance Law, so-called.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety of the General Laws is hereby
2 further amended by striking out section one A,
3 inserted by section one of chapter three hundred
4 and sixty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and
5 twenty-six, and inserting in place thereof the fol-
6 lowing: —

7 *Section 1A.* No motor vehicle or trailer, except
8 one owned by a person, firm or corporation for the
9 operation of which security is required to be fur-
10 nished under section forty-six of chapter one hun-
11 dred and fifty-nine, or by a street railway company
12 under public control or by the commonwealth or
13 any political subdivision thereof, shall be registered
14 under sections two to five, inclusive, unless the ap-
15 plication therefor is accompanied by a certificate
16 as defined in thirty-four A.
