### RESOLVE

Providing for the **Expenses** under an Act in relation to the **Boundaries of Cities and Towns** bordering upon the Sea.

*Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth the sum of five hundred dollars, to be expended by the board of harbor and land commissioners, with the approval of the governor and council, for the employment of surveyors, for clerical assistance and other necessary expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of chapter one hundred and ninety-six of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, entitled, "An act in relation to the boundaries of cities and towns bordering on the sea."
