AN ACT TO EXEMPT COUNCILLOR PETER KOLSON FROM MASSACHUSETTS  
GENERAL LAW CHAPTER 268A, SECTION 20.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other general or special  
2 order to the contrary, including but not limited to Chapter 268A,  
3 section 20 of the General Laws there shall be no prohibition on  
4 Peter Kolson, an employee of the Quincy Housing Authority,  
5 from holding an elected position of City Councillor in the City  
6 of Quincy, and receiving compensation for his Housing Authority  
7 duties and for his duties as a City Councillor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
