**AN ACT TO CONTINUE REINDEMNIFYING ELECTED OR APPOINTED
MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS OF THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 512 of the Acts
2 of 1978 entitled "Claims and Indemnity Procedure for the
3 Commonwealth, Its Municipalities, Counties and Districts and
4 the Officers and Employees Thereof" the municipal officers
5 elected or appointed of any Town which has previously ac-
6 cepted Section 1001 of Chapter 41 of the General Laws shall
7 continue to be indemnified and saved harmless from personal
8 financial loss and expense including reasonable legal fees and
9 costs, if any, in an amount not to exceed one million dollars
10 arising out of any claim, demand, suit or judgment by reason
11 of any act or omission including a violation of the civil rights
12 of any person under any federal law, if the official at the time
13 of such act or omission was acting within the scope of his
14 official duties or employment.
